Ministerial Resolution No. 1559/1 on 22/06/1431 AH

Minister of Labor,

Having perused Article (122) and Article (243) of the Labor Law promulgated by Royal Decree No. M/51 on 23/08/1426 AH;

Having Perused Ministerial Resolution No. 551/1 on 17/02/1429 AH;

Based upon the instructions of the Honorable Council of Ministers contained in Telegram No. 25686/B on 02/06/1431 AH by the Council of Ministers Court.

IT IS RESOLVED:

First: Worker may not work in outdoor jobs exposed to the sunlight from twelve o'clock in the

afternoon until three o'clock in the evening during the period between the tenth day of Cancer, corresponding to the first of July, to the end of the ninth day of Virgo, corresponding to the end

of August of each year.

Second: On regulating working hours in accordance with the provisions of Articles 98, 99 and 100 of the

Labor Law, employer shall take into account the provisions of the first paragraph of this

Resolution.

Third: Workers who work in oil and gas companies, as well as emergency maintenance workers, shall

be excluded from this Resolution, provided that necessary measures are taken to protect them

from harm due to sunlight.

Fourth Violation of this Resolution shall be subject to the penalty stipulated in Article (236) of the Labor

Law.

Fifth: This Resolution shall come into effect as of 1436 AH – 2011 AD.

Sixth: Undersecretary for Labor Affairs shall enforce this Resolution.

We send you herewith a copy of Letter No. 1378 on 27/05/1431 AH by His Excellency the Secretary-General of the Council of Ministers, in response to our Telegram No. 28661/B on 11/07/1430 AH, which informs of the kind instructions to present Letter No. 2348/1 on 01/07/1430 AH to the Council of Ministers, attached thereto a Draft Ministerial Resolution regulating working hours under the sunlight,

As clarified by His Excellency that the Council of Ministers perused this matter during the meeting held on 26/05/1431 AH under the chairmanship of, the Custodian of the Two Holy Mosques, the Prime Minister – may Allah protect him – as well as perusing the kind instructions, Minutes No. (76) on 19/02/1431 AH of the Board of Experts in the Council of Ministers prepared in this regard, and the recommendation of the General Committee of the Council of Ministers made in this regard. Council of Ministers instructed the Ministry of Laborto include the following in the Draft Ministerial Resolution for determining working hours under the sunlight:

- 1. Workers who work in oil and gas companies, as well as emergency maintenance workers, shall be excluded from (First) Clause of this Draft Resolution, provided that necessary measures are taken to protect them from harm due to sunlight.
- 2. Emphasize the application of penalties stipulated in the Labor Law against violators of the Resolution.

We hope to peruse and complete the necessary actions as instructed by the Council of Ministers.
