Abstract	
<p>Art. 1 grants foreigners access to medical service under the health insurance and medical security systems.</p> <p>Art. 2 requires the employer to obtain and pay for the foreign worker's health insurance policy. This condition must be met before the worker can be granted a residence permit.</p> <p>Art. 4 lists the main health and medical services that must be covered by health insurance.</p> <p>Art. 12 lists the categories of individuals which shall not be subject to the health insurance provided for in this law.</p>
