Abstract	<p><i>Keywords: Saudi Arabia, Laws & Regulations, Labour Migration, Work Conditions</i></p> <p>This decision is in implementation of Art. 99 of the Labor Law (Royal Decree M/51).</p> <p>The working hours shall be increased to nine hours a day for those working in the following places (Art. 1):</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Restaurants2. Hotels and hotel apartments3. Cafes4. Cafeterias5. Hospitals, Dispensaries and Medical Clinics6. Markets and Commercial Shops7. Barber and Tailor Shops8. Gas Stations <p>The working hours shall be decreased to seven hours a day for those working in the following sectors (Art. 2):</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Mechanical Industries2. Construction Industries3. Textile Industries4. Chemical Industries5. Leather Industry6. Paper Industry7. Wood Industries8. Working underground
