Abstract	<p>Citizens of the Gulf Cooperation Council (GCC) are permitted to engage in economic activity in the fields of industry, agriculture, animal and fish wealth, and contracting (Art. 1).</p> <p>The contribution of GCC citizens in the capital of a company established to practice any of the aforementioned activities may reach up to 75% (Art. 2).</p>
