<b>Abstract</b>	<p>In accordance with Art. 1, Gulf Cooperation Council (GCC) citizens may in engage in the following economic activity in the State of Kuwait:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Examination and inspection of goods</li><li>2. Operation and maintenance of machines</li></ol> <p>Art. 2 permits GCC citizens to engage in the aforementioned economic activity in accordance with a number of provisions listed in this article. The provisions are also applicable to all other economic activity approved by the Higher Council.</p>
