<b>Abstract</b>	
<p>Craftsmen who are citizens of the Gulf Cooperation Council (GCC) are permitted to practice their craft in the State of Kuwait (Art. 1).</p> <p>Craftsmen who wish to practice their craft in Kuwait must have the necessary qualification and permanently reside in Kuwait. They must also practice the craft themselves (Art. 2).</p> <p>GCC citizens must obtain the necessary registration and license required of Kuwaiti citizens to practice the craft (Art. 3).</p>
