Abstract	<p>Citizens of the Gulf Cooperation Council (GCC) can register to practice any of the following professions in the State of Kuwait (Art. 1):</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Medicine• Law• Accounting• Engineering• Consultancies (Administrative, Economic, Agricultural, Industrial, Technical) <p>GCC citizens have to obtain the proper registration and license required of Kuwaiti citizens before they can practice these professions (Art. 2).</p>
