Keywords: Oman, Laws & Regulations, National & Foreign Labour Without prejudice to any better benefit prescribed for a worker, the minimum periodical raise paid shall be no less than 3% of his basic salary to be dispensed from the 1^{st} of January of every year (Art. 1). Art. 2 lists the conditions that must be met for a worker to be granted the periodical raise:

- 1. Working for at least six months with the employer
- 2. Not receiving a weak assessment in the annual performance report.
