Abstract

Keywords: Oman, Laws & Regulations, Citizenship, NaturalisationThis law is applicable to citizens of Oman employed in the private sector under a permanent work contract or working in one of the Gulf Cooperation Council countries. It does not cover foreign workers, household workers, selfemployed persons, and artisans.

In 2006, the law was amended to include Article 22 (Bis) A, B & C. These relate to the right of foreigners working in the private sector who become naturalised citizens to benefit from Social Insurance for the period of time prior to the law coming into effect if certain conditions are met and procedures are followed.
