The Ministry of National Economy of Oman has conducted three censuses in 1993, 2003 and 2010.

**The date of reference for census 2010 is December 12, 2010.** Period of implementation: December 12 to 21, 2010. The Sultanate uses the de jure and the de facto approach in the enumeration.
