<b>Abstract</b>	<p>Article 38 of the constitution stipulates that no citizen of the state of Qatar shall ever be exiled from the country or denied re-entry.</p> <p>Article 41 of the constitution establishes that Qatari citizenship and the rules governing it are to be prescribed by laws which shall have the same power as the constitution.</p> <p>Article 58 prohibits the extradition of political refugees and determines that the conditions for granting political asylum shall be established by law.</p>
