<b>Abstract</b>	<p>Anyone who smuggles or assists or conspires to smuggle, persons who are not carrying documents that prove their identities and nationalities in or out of the country, shall be penalized by paying an amount ranging from 2000 to 5000 Riyals and/or imprisonment for a period of time ranging from five months to two years (Art. 52 (5) – <b>Amended</b>).</p>
