## **1. Technical Notes and Definitions**

**Sampling frame** of LFS 2014 Round 1: Population Census 2010.

**Sample size:** 33500 households

**Reference period:** January 2014.

**Population of reference:** all individuals (nationals and non-nationals) residing in the Kingdom during the period of reference.

The ultimate sampling unit is the household.
