## ANNEXED NOTE

### 1. Characteristics of data, definitions

Since 2011, Islands were merged with Abu Dhabi Region and Al Gharbia. All numbers are rounded to the nearest 1000 persons, therefore, numbers may not add to totals.

The population data in the Statistical Yearbook includes Census data up to 2005 and mid-year estimates of the usual resident population from 2006. The population estimates include people who are usual residents, temporary absents and Emirati citizens away from the Emirate, who are legally entitled to live in UAE. The mid-year 2015 population estimate is preliminary and subject to revision.
