## **Abstract**

The Ministry of Human Resources and Emiratization (MoHRE) has reorganized the Tawteen Partners Club membership. It is an effort to increase the private sector's rate of Emiratization in line with UAE goals. The new criteria state that organizations falling under Category 1 for private sector establishments either increase Emiratization rates by no less than thrice the annual target, provided that no fewer than 30 additional Emiratis are appointed, or collaborate with the Emirati Talent Competitiveness Council (Nafis) to hire and train at least 500 Emiratis annually, to qualify for membership in the Tawteen Partners Club.
