Non-resident Interns

The Gulf Labour Markets, Migration, and Population (GLMM) Programme, hosted and supported by the Gulf Research Center (GRC), invites students to join its team as Non-resident Interns.

Affiliation is between 3 and 9 months (renewable), during which interns conduct activities related to GLMM's research programmes based on their expertise and interests, in close coordination with a senior GLMM staff member. Interns are encouraged to prepare work for publication on GLMM's website, social media platforms, and newsletter.

GLMM invites applications from students who have completed at least a B.A. and are enrolled in an M.A. or Ph.D. programme, and whose work focuses on thematic areas that are congruent with those of the GLMM programme.

Candidates should have:

- A B.A. degree or higher in a relevant discipline (e.g., Demography, Statistics, Law, Economics, Political Science, Sociology, Middle East Studies, Migration Studies)
- Proven knowledge of academic research and publishing relating to the GCC countries
- Strong proficiency in the English language
- Preferably a working knowledge of the Arabic language
- Commitment to GLMM's mission

To apply, interested students must submit:

- (1) Curriculum vitae
- (2) Relevant writing sample (thesis chapter or academic paper)
- (3) Brief motivation for seeking affiliation with GLMM
